This month of September, we would like to invite you to meditate on the Seven Sorrows of Mary, the Mother of Jesus. Whenever I encounter any hardship in my life, I turn to this devotion to remind me of the greater sorrow of Jesus' mother. As we meditate on these seven sorrows let us relate the sorrows we have of the many pregnancies that have been terminated

The following are the Seven Sorrows of Mary:

1. The prophecy of Simeon. Luke 2:32-35. This is when Simeon came to the holy family and prophesied that "this Child is destined for the falling and rising of many in Israel... and a sword will pierce your own soul, too."
2. The flight to Egypt. Matthew 2:13-15. After the three magis left after their visit to the Christ Child, an angel appeared in Joseph's dream to tell him that the Holy Family need to flee to Egypt, "for Herod is in search of the Child, to destroy him."
3. The loss of Jesus in the temple of Jerusalem. Luke 2:41-52. The Holy Family went to Jerusalem every year for the feast of the Passover. However, when Jesus was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem as was their annual pilgrimage, upon returning, his parents could not find him. They sought him and after "three days, they saw him at the temple "sitting and listening among the teachers."
4. Jesus carries his cross. John 19:17. "So they took Jesus; and carrying the cross by Himself, He went out to what is called the place of the Skull, which in Hebrew is called Golgotha."
5. The death of our Lord, Jesus Christ. John 19:25-30. "So they put a sponge full of sour wine on a branch of hyssop and held it to His mouth...When Jesus received the wine, He said, "It is finished." Then He bowed His head and gave up His Spirit."
6. Christ's body is pierced and taken down from the cross. Psalm 22:15, John 19:31-37. "So the soldiers came and broke the legs of the first and the other who had been crucified with him; but when they came to Jesus, and saw that He was already dead, they did not break his legs. But one of the soldiers pierced his side with a spear, and at once there came out blood and water."
7. The Burial of Christ. John 19:38-42. " After this, Joseph of Arimathea... asked Pilate that he may take away the body of Jesus, and Pilate gave him leave... Nicodemus, also came bringing myrrh and aloes.... They took the body of Jesus and bound it in linen cloths with the spices, as is the burial custom of the Jews. Now in the place where he was crucified there was a garden, and in the garden a new tomb where no one had ever been laid. So because of the Jewish day of Preparation, as the tomb was close at hand, they laid Jesus there."
